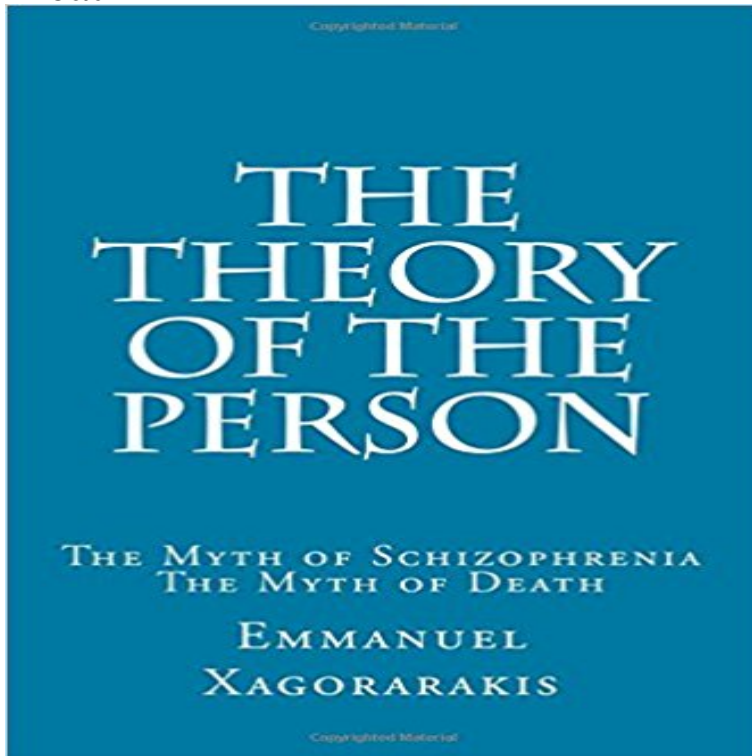


The Theory of the Person: The Myth of Schizophrenia, The Myth of Death
