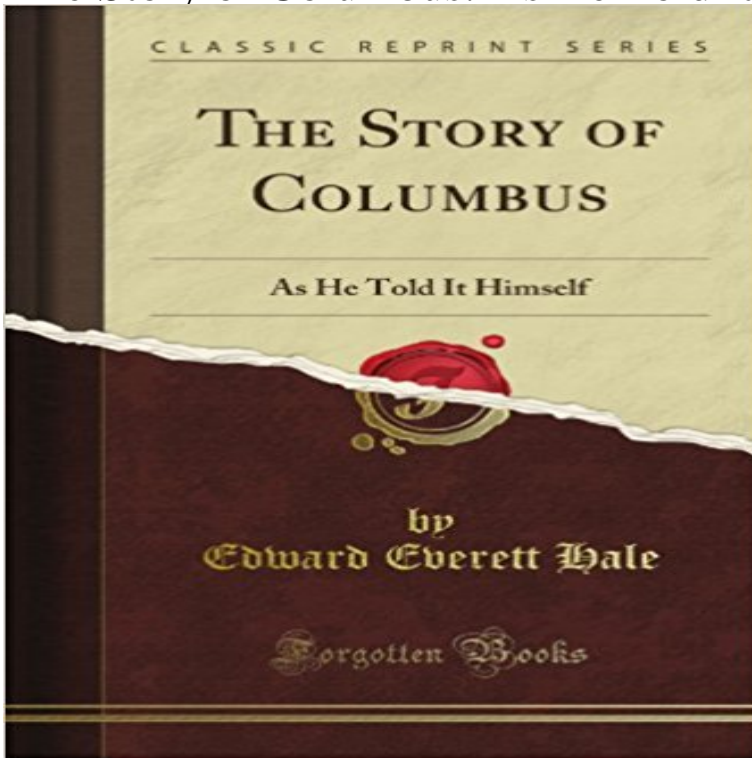


# The Story of Columbus: As He Told It Himself (Classic Reprint)

I do not myself believe that it is wise to attempt, in a book of biography, so considerable a study of the history of the time. Whether it be wise or not, I have not attempted it in this book.
