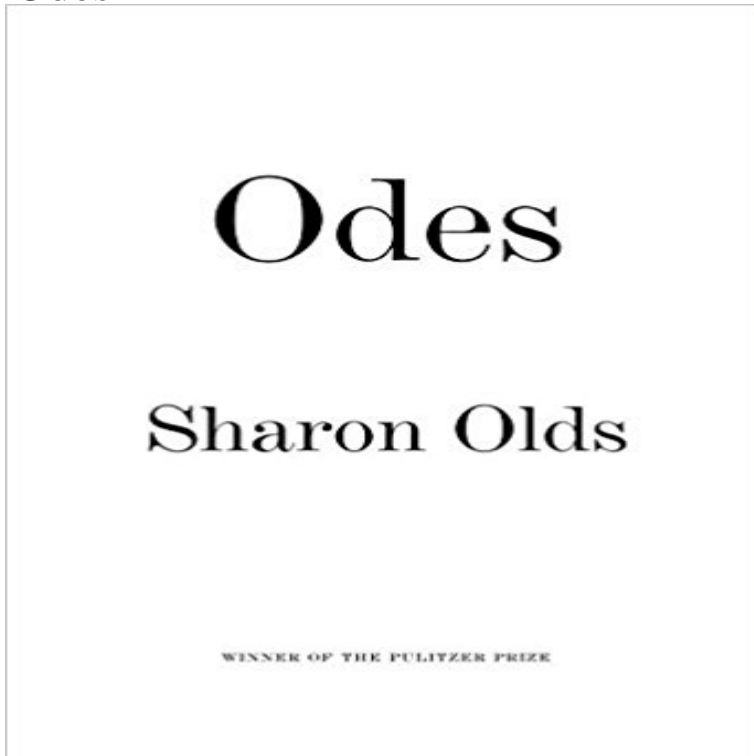


Odes
