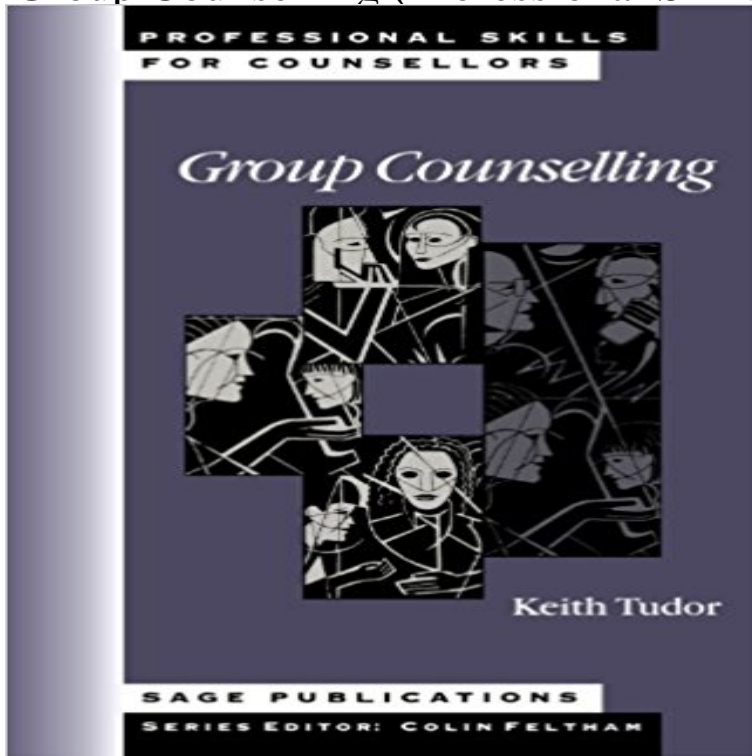


Group Counselling (Professional Skills for Counsellors Series)
