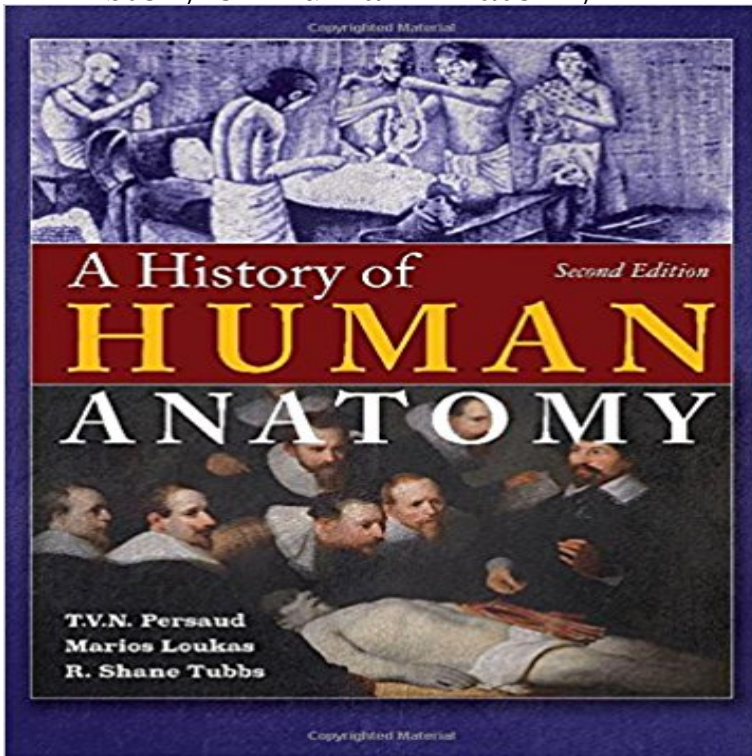


A History of Human Anatomy
