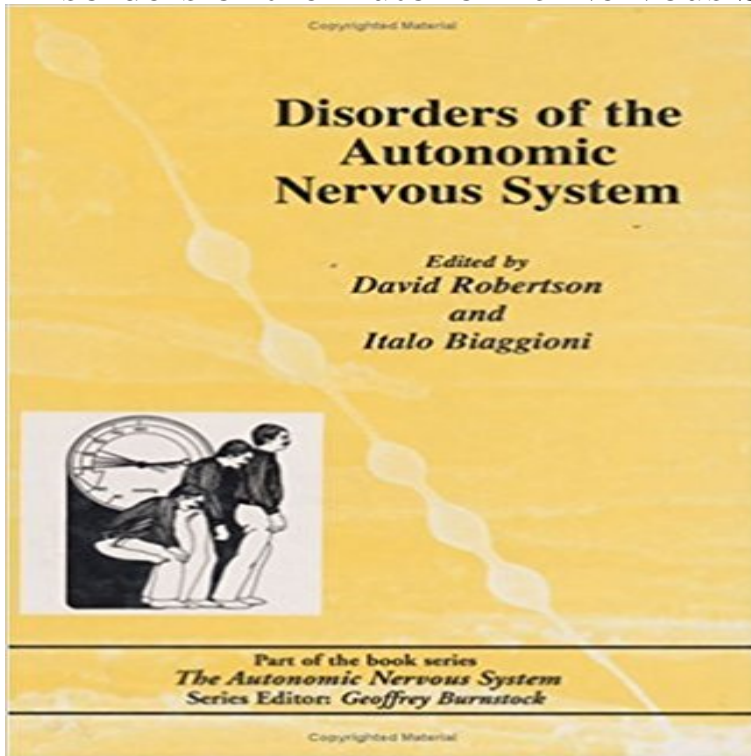


Disorders of the Autonomic Nervous System
