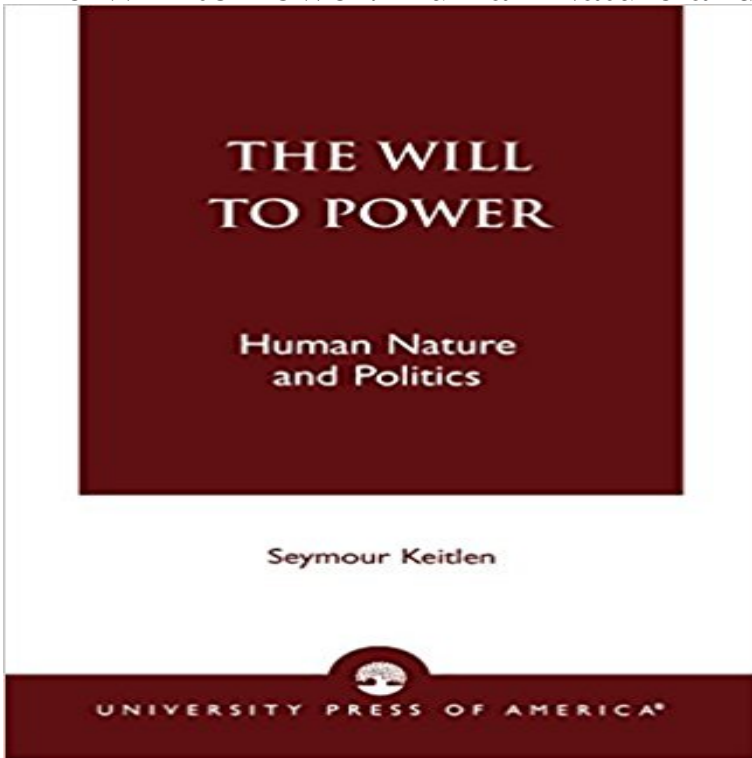


The Will to Power: Human Nature and Politics
