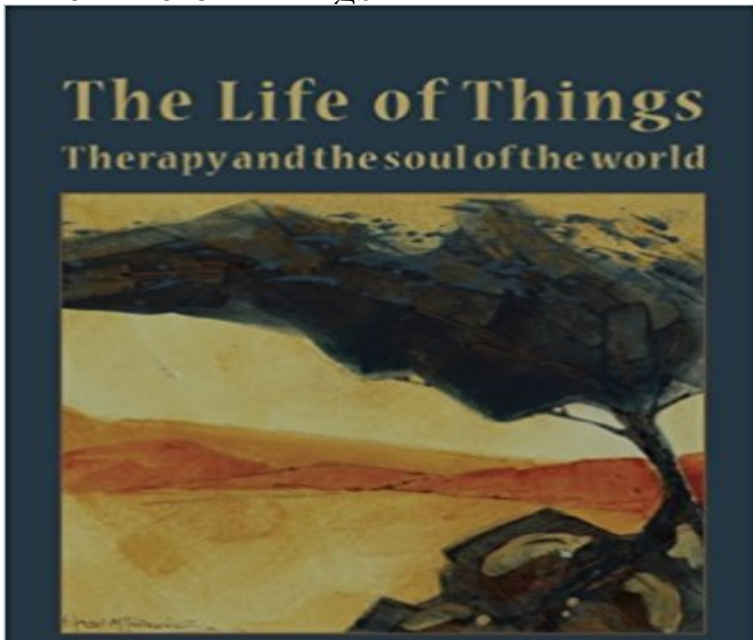


The Life of Things
